ADAM GILCHRIST ONLY FOUR SIXES AWAY!

Adam Gilchrist is only four sixes away from securing 25 modified bikes for children with disabilities.

So far, Adam has hit 21 sixes as Captain of the Deccan Chargers in the Indian Premier League (IPL). During the last IPL, Adam hit 19 sixes.

If Adam hits 25 sixes, Amway will fund the 'gift of wheels' for 25 children with disabilities. Every bike is modified to suit the child. This allows children with disabilities to enjoy riding a bike for the first time in their lives.

Today, Amway announced it had provided \$10,000 to provide 15 more modified bikes for children with disabilities. This will mean 15 more children will receive the 'gift of wheels'.

So if Adam hits 25 sixes, Amway will fund 40 modified bikes.

Adam said he will re-double his efforts to reach his target of 25 sixes.

"The bikes bring so much happiness to children with disabilities. So I am going to try and hit as many sixes as I can," Adam Gilchrist said.

"Helping kids is a great incentive to send the ball back over the bowler's head and over the fence."

Speaking on behalf of Amway and service provider Technical Aid to the Disabled, Michial Coldwell said "We are delighted Adam is hitting so many sixes and helping to fund modified bikes for kids. It will mean the world of difference for these children. And it brings back happy memories of when Adam was wearing the baggy green cap!"
