



1 Staying switched off very good for the bank balance

NEW energy saving initiatives have seen Amway at Castle Hill reduce their greenhouse gas emissions by 680 tonnes a year.

Amway has permanently switched off 97 of its 400W globes and installed energy efficient lighting.

Amway Australia general manager Michial Coldwell said: "We are doing our bit to help our planet."

Lighting energy use has now been reduced by more than 40 per cent in the warehouse alone.

"We want to reduce our carbon footprint and protect the interests of future generations," Mr Coldwell said.

"This is an ongoing mission.

"As good as saving 680 tonnes of carbon dioxide is, we are now asking ourselves what else can we do?"



Mr Coldwell said the change would benefit the business as well as the environment.

"An added bonus is that we save money, not a lot but it's good to know that doing good for the planet can also be good for the bank balance," he said.

Amway has been operating in Castle Hill for more than 30 years and employs 200 people.
